a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

All staff will be trained to understand their responsibilities under the Act to promote the four Licensing Objectives.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV to the requirements of the Police and Licensing authority will be operated at the premises.

Staff will be trained to understand that they must not serve a person who is or appears to be under age or a person who appears to be drunk.

The Challenge 25 Scheme will be adopted.

There will be no off sales after 03 :00hrs.

Door Supervision:

Fridays, Saturdays and Bank Holiday Sundays –

One Door Supervisor from 22:00hrs to close of premises.

One Door Supervisor from 23:00hrs to close of premises.

c) Public safety

Management and staff will be trained to identify safety risk factors to patrons and staff on the premises.

The fire exit will be left unobstructed and staff will familiarise themselves with the position of firefighting equipment and evacuation procedures.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

When Regulated Music is being played:

All doors and windows will be shut except for ingress and egress.

A sound limiter, set to a standard agreed with the Environmental Health Dept. will be used.

Patrons will be encouraged to leave the premises quietly so as not to disturb neighbours.

A notice will be placed on the door requesting patrons to leave the area quietly.

e) The protection of children from harm

There will be no adult entertainment.
