We are writing to register our objection to the application of Mr. Thamotharampillai Thavakuamar's premises licence who already owns a Off-Licence shop in Broadstairs called St. Peters Stores at 27 Beacon Road, CT10 3DF Broadstairs and residing in the same address.

We learnt that Mr. Thavakumar who has tendered an application for an Off-Licence to open up a shop in Margate Sea front.

Mr. Thavakumar has breached the Law of Off-Licence by selling illicit Alcoholic, for which he was punished by the Local Authority. The basis for this opposition is that granting a licence for this premise will not promote the licensing objectives, particularly the prevention of crime, disorder and antisocial behaviour.

As we have many Homeless Alcoholics who are dwelling in the sea front Roofed Veranda and thus enabling them a short walking distance to obtain their Alcoholic drinks.

Granting a licence would provide a further source of alcohol within an area already so heavily populated with licensed premises that crime, disorder and public nuisance have already reached problem levels for the local police.

Residents in this area already suffer noise nuisance and antisocial behaviour at all hours of the day and night. They have endured enough inconvenience, and it is totally unacceptable to expect them to continue to do so.

We would also urge the Council to consider the findings regarding Mr. Thavakumar's breach of the Alcohol Licence, which is an evidence of his negative conduct to the responsibility of an Off-Licence holder. Further more we would like state that The Licensing Act Notice for public view is not displayed in the premises

In view of the above, we would urge the Licensing Authority to refuse the application.
