Summary of Expected Decision:	Granting permission to spend the £750k externally funded project for the Capital Works Programme for 51-57 High Street, Margate.
Reason Item is Not in Forward Plan:	It was not possible for this item to be added to the Forward Plan with a 28 day lead time before the cabinet meeting on 28 January 2021 due to procurement needing to start as early as possible in the new year. Following an urgent decision to add the £750k funded project to the Capital Works Programme, a subsequent decision is now needed to agree the spending of these funds. It is vital that procurement can commence immediately in order to meet the delivery deadlines set by the funder, therefore a decision is needed on 28 January. The project team has provided information for the Forward Plan as swiftly as possible in preparation for the meeting on 28 January 2021.
