

Thanet District Council's Proposed Leaders report rules

2.1 Order of Business

Ordinary meetings of the Council shall commence at 7.00 pm unless otherwise agreed with the Chairman and will take place on a Thursday in accordance with a programme decided at the Council's annual meeting. Ordinary meetings will:

- (xi) receive reports from the Cabinet Leader, Members of the Cabinet and the Council's Committees etc;

2.2 Leaders report

The Leader of the Council may make an oral report, not exceeding ten minutes, on key issues arising since the last meeting of Council.

The Leaders of the Opposition and any other Political Group may comment on the Leader's report, but no other Member may speak except with the consent of the Chairman. The comments of the Leaders of the opposition and other Political Groups shall be limited each to five minutes.

The Leader has a right of reply, limited to two minutes, to any comments made on his/ her report.

No motions may be moved nor resolutions passed under this item.
