Item	Comment received	KCC response
1.	Monkton Road: Could the sign be placed 50 yards closer to Monkton village so the flashing lights will not be seen from the resident's property?	Relocating the sign this short distance should not reduce its effectiveness when entering Minster. A suitable location to relocate the sign 50 yards from its originally proposed site has already been identified.
2.	Monkton Road: The sign needs to be 250 yards closer to Hoo Farm. In its proposed location the sign would have no benefit to Hoo Farm residents.	Relocating the sign such a distance from Minster village would severely reduce its effect in Minster. By the time drivers pass the sign and reach Minster speeds will have increased as they entered the village.
3.	Monkton Road: Please could an additional interactive sign be sited near the properties located at Hoo Farm?	The costs of an additional interactive sign would be beyond the scope of this scheme. However, the member may wish to request an additional sign within his next years member Highway Fund allocation, if funding allows.
4.	Tothill Street: Please could the sign be located closer to the junction with Hill House Drive where it will have a greater benefit?	Comment noted. A suitable location has been identified on which to relocate the sign.
5.	Tothill Street: In addition to the new interactive sign could a gateway feature be installed in Tothill Street at the change of speed limit.	The costs of a new gateway feature are beyond the scope of this scheme.
6.	Tothill Street and Monkton Road: Minster Parish Council supports the proposed introduction of interactive signs in the village.	Comment noted.
