# Summary: To update the Standards Committee on the progress of Informal Resolution of Complaints and results of Investigations.

# For Decision

# 1.0 Introduction and Background

- 1.1 *Arrangements for Dealing with Code of Conduct Complaints* adopted by council in July 2012 made changes in the method of reporting results of Informal Resolution of complaints and Investigation Reports.
- 1.2 The Monitoring Officer reports to committee on the results of informal resolution and 'No Breach' Investigation Reports.

## 2.0 Informal Resolution of Complaints

- 2.1 No Cases were referred to the Monitoring Officer for Informal Resolution for the period of June August 2013.
- 2.2 Referring a complaint to the Monitoring Officer for Other Action is a disposal of the complaint.

## 3.0 Investigation Reports

- 3.1 Since the 6 June meeting of the Standards Committee 2 investigations have been completed (one a Parish Councillor and one a District Councillor, carried out by separate investigators).
- 3.2 In both cases the investigators found no breach of the Code of Conduct.
- 3.3 In line with the current arrangements the Independent Person was consulted by the Monitoring Officer, who concurred with the reports' findings that no further action should be taken.
- 3.4 Reporting the outcome of a 'No Breach' investigation report to the Standards Committee is the final stage of the complaint process and these 2 cases are now closed.

## 4.0 Hearings

- 4.1 The Standards Hearings Sub-Committee was convened on 5 June 2013 to hear Standards Complaint TDCSC93/12.
- 4.2 The Councillor was found to be in breach of the Code of Conduct
- 4.2 The Sanctions for the case

- The Decision Notice to be published on the Council's website for a period of 3 months
- That the Council be requested to issue a press release apologising to the complainant on behalf of the council and deploring the actions of an elected member of Thanet District Council.
- 4.3 However prior to the 'naming and shaming' of the Councillor, the complainant requested no publicity. The Decision Notice was published on the Council's website in a redacted form.
