1.	Good idea to keep Taylor Road free of parked cars especially during school run but cars and lorries will still park on the build out which is outside of the butchers, vehicles will still park from the build out down Taylor Road to the new lay-by so you will still only get one lane of traffic . You should put yellow lines all the way down from the build out to the new lay by as well. (Resident)	Comment noted. Would seek to provide yellow lines to both sides of Taylor Road, where necessary.
2.	I feel I must bring to your attention that these new yellow lines would have to be on the whole self-enforcing due to their location. (TDC Parking Office)	Comments noted. The yellow lines are expected to be self-enforcing.
3.	Signing needs to be in accordance with Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and Chapters 3 and 5 of the Traffic Signs Manual. The TRO needs to be in the main self-enforcing.(Kent Police)	Signing will accord to current standards.
4.	These proposals will help the bus getting to or from the school, so we would support this. (Stagecoach).	Comments noted.
