1.0 Introduction and Background

1.1 When the Petitions Scheme was reviewed in light of the Localism Act 2011, a new clause was introduced to require the Council's Monitoring Officer to report to the Council's Overview and Scrutiny Panel when a petition was rejected.

2.0 The Current Situation

2.1 The Council received an petition on the 7 August 2014 from a member of the public:

"This petition is in response to the proposal to put yellow lines in Approach Road. As it stands at present we have to fight to park anyway. There are also several of us who have a blue badge and cannot walk far. It is not necessary to put yellow lines on this road and we feel it will make parking even more difficult than it already is. Please reconsider this proposal".

- 2.2 The petitioner was advised that, as the petition was only signed by 19 people, the petition had not reached the minimum threshold of 25 signatories in order to become a valid petition in accordance with the Council's petition scheme, therefore the petition was referred to the Parking department to be treated as a piece of correspondence.
