It has come to my attention that the Carlton Cinema wishes to extend its licenced hours for late night viewings, extending into the early hours.

As someone who lives very close to the Carlton, I would like to bring my concerns to your attention.

My main objection is regarding the parking and the noise at late hours, which will cause disruption to the local residents. The coming and going of vehicles and people between midnight and 3 am will create a lot of noise affecting the sleep of residents in the surrounding area.

We are writing to express our concerns at the proposal of the Carlton Cinema to extend their existing licensing hours until 3 am for 'infrequent' midnight showings.

We realise that the Carlton Cinema is a great asset to Westgate and provides a very valuable and enjoyable service to the community.

However, as residents who live very close to the Carlton, we have grave concerns and feel that we have to object to this proposal on the following grounds:

- The Carlton Cinema does not have a car park.
   Its customers, many of whom arrive in cars, need to park in the adjacent streets, which are
   all residential. The late arrival and departure of vehicles, as well as pedestrians, leaving the
   cinema will mean excessive noise and disturbance at unsociable hours.

- 4) Although the Carlton Cinema has stated that the screenings will be 'infrequent', this needs much further clarification as to the frequency of such events.


