Dear Joanne,

I am the Environmental Health Officer responding to your application for a premises licence at Millie's Beach Bar.

I would like you to agree to the following conditions to control noise from customers and noise from amplified music: -

- The Licence holder shall erect and maintain clear and prominent notices displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- When live music or recorded music takes place inside the premises all doors and windows will be kept shut.
- No amplified music is to be permitted unless a noise management plan, which has been agreed with the Local Authority, is in place. The noise management plan shall be periodically reviewed and/or when significant changes occur in the operation, building or event type or following a complaint.

I would be grateful if you could confirm your agreement to these conditions at your earliest convenience.
