Hi Jane

I have spoken with the applicant Ross and agreed the condition below. I therefore withdraw my objection.

The cumulative effects of litter in the vicinity of premises carrying on licensable activity could cause a public nuisance. In this instance it is appropriate and necessary for a condition of a licence to require premises serving customers to provide a daily litter collection in the vicinity of the premises in order to prevent the accumulation of litter from its customers.

Condition:

A member of staff shall carry out a daily litter pick of Botany Bay beach collecting any discarded cups used for the sale of alcohol. A record detailing the name of the member of staff, time and date of each collection along with trade waste collection records shall be kept and available on request.
