As a resident of Broadstairs (my address is [REDACTED]), I wish to raise the following objections to the following application:

The Table Group Ltd, The Table – 9 York Street Broadstairs, CT10 1PD

New Premises Licence Under Section 17 Supply of Alcohol
12 (midday) – 23:00pm Daily

Opening hours

9:00am – Midnight Mon-Sat

9:00am – 11:00pm Sunday

My objections are under the 4 main Objectives:-

- **the prevention of crime and disorder.**

In Chandos Road and York street we have an ongoing issue with a group of men and women gathering at varying times of the day and night dealing in Drugs and drinking alcohol Incident number 01-0418. I feel that a new premises selling Alcohol will only cause more crime and disorder.

- **public safety.**

Chandos Road which leads to York Street is very narrow and only has a narrow footpath for some of its length. Traffic attending The Table would cause congestion and parking problems for residents in Chandos Road and York Street and people attending church either for services or weddings, funerals, baptisms, etc..

- **the prevention of public nuisance.**

Any Noise would adversely affect residents living in the vicinity of the Table and would also carry across the whole area especially as the license application covers the late night opening. The location of various residential homes that already have to deal with litter and noise from other venues in the vicinity.

The supply of alcohol until midnight will subject local residents to antisocial behavior and noise.

- **The protection of children from harm.**

York Street contains residential houses, a Nursery School, and the Methodist Church, who would be particularly affected by any disruption. Parents, Carer's and emergency services could also be subjected to delays and parking problems.

There isn't a forecourt or space outside No 9 York Street for people to pass by safely if users of the venue are standing outside. Particular concern for people using the venue with obstructive views to oncoming one way traffic.

Finally I would like to add the main points are that I am concerned about the noise level and litter and general disturbance to the area which is already being seen as a hiding area for drug dealing as no CCTV.

I trust that this has reached you before the deadline of the 19th July 2019 and I will hear from you in due course.
