I have been advised that the Town Council do support the Premises Licence variation for the St Mildreds Bay but are asking if there can be further conditions. The following comments and observations are:-

- In other establishments nearby (Millies Beach Bar, West Bay Café and the Swan Public House) it is not necessary to have a meal in order to buy an alcoholic beverage.
- The proviso on this site should be that alcohol must only be consumed on the premises – this includes the attached veranda – but does not include the public promenade.
- The Town Council however is still concerned about the late opening hours of the St Mildreds Bay and the effect this will have on our residents living opposite the premises.
- We understand that the conditions ask for the doors and windows to be closed at 9 pm, however we are concerned that these conditions will not be sufficient to protect our residents from public nuisance harm.

I know that the Premises Licence variation does not permit for the revisiting of the whole licence so am I correct that the comments and request for further conditions cannot be considered at this time?
