I am emailing my objection concerning the latest license variation for The St Mildred's Bay, St Mildreds Gardens, Westgate On Sea, Kent, CT8 8TP.

The variation seeks to remove the following conditions:

Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to persons taking table meals there and for consumption by such a person as an ancillary to his meal.

It is an implied condition of this licence that suitable beverages other than intoxicating liquor (including drinking water) shall be equally available for consumption with or as an ancillary to meals served in the licensed premises.

In line with my previous representations concerning this premises I do not feel that the location is suitable for a drinking establishment and late night venue. The amount of objections received from members of the public shows the weight of concern about the proposals for this venue. In light of the Sub Committee decision following the recent licensing hearing to allow the premises to extend its operating hours the removal of the conditions will allow the premises to operate as a late night drinking establishment. Consideration could be given to amend these times by agreement.

Removing the above conditions would not support the licensing objective 'the prevention of public nuisance' and I therefore wish to submit my objection.
