1.0 Introduction and Background

1.1 Following the general Election and the forming of a new Government by a Conservative/Liberal Democrat coalition, new policies have been announced.

The Coalition published a document setting out headline policies on 20th May 2010. I have extracted the announcements relevant to local government and in particular this Council and these appear as an annex to the report. The Corporate Management team have undertaken a quick assessment of the impact of the proposals which appears in the narrative at Annex 1.

2.0 The Current Situation

- 2.1 Members of the Cabinet are requested to review and note the impact of the policies.
- 2.2 EMERGENCY BUDGET On 24th May 2010 the Chancellor announced details of an emergency budget introducing £6.2bn of public expenditure reductions. Of this local government is expected to fund £1.165bn of savings. An announcement by the Communities and Local Government Department on the detail was expected on 2nd June but has been delayed and not yet released at the time of writing this report.
- 2.3 QUEEN'S SPEECH The Queen's speech on 25th May 2010 set out details of the forthcoming legislative programme. I have enclosed the full LGA on the day briefing which sets out the main implications for local government at Annex 2.
- 2.4 NEXT STEPS The Cabinet is asked to consider the current position and the implications for the Council. As there is to be a national emergency budget announcement on 22nd June, it is recommended that a full, more detailed report be provided to the next Council meeting for all members to consider.
