List of objections to licensing application for sale of alcohol on the
"Arts Barge" in Ramsgate Harbour.

- 1). The barge is a previously condemned, rusting hulk which was towed into the harbour for crowd funding purposes.
- 2). The barge is a health and safety hazard for public access.
- 3). The barge is located in a working harbour which is a very hazardous environment.
- 4). There are no public toilets aboard, and no facilities for disposal of sewage.
- 5). There are no facilities for the hygienic service of food and drink to the public.
- 6). The whole facility and environment would be hazardous for school children's art classes.
- 7). The late night opening hours would be a disturbance to boat owners and live-a-boards in the harbour and also adjacent flat dwellers.
- 8). Further more the vast amount of construction work required to bring this rusting hulk up to spec. would not be allowed to be carried out within the harbour, as it would be contrary to the harbour bylaws.
