Details of Course Contents:

Taxi Driver Remedial Training

For drivers who have been flagged to the LA due to a lapse in driving standards or customer service issues

Green Penny (all tests with a driven element are carried out in drivers own vehicle)

The course content includes:

- Legal requirements: Driving Licence, eyesight and vehicle checks
- Presentation discussing skills-based driving, Cabology, eco driving, hazard perception and an overview of risk management and driver responsibilities.
- Further issues can be included (upon request from council) in relevant areas of the course.
- 1 hour on road assessment including debrief and feedback.
- 1.5 hours on road remedial training and coaching.
- Final report, feedback and certificate of completion is issued to all candidates. Where a candidate has met or exceeded the required standard, a certificate of achievement is issued instead of certificate of completion.
- Final report is submitted to relevant council (with permission from driver for GDPR compliance).

Blue Lamp Trust (online virtual classroom session)

Course aims:

to provide drivers with knowledge and understanding of their responsibilities and best practice protocols to provide safe and secure transport to all passengers.

The course content includes:

- reducing driving risk risks associated with driving a Taxi or Private Hire vehicle and the consequences of failing to manage those risks
- identification of speed limits and explaining how hazards and distractions affect driving.
- improving passenger safety human cost of collisions and explore coping strategies to reduce driving risk
- a Highway Code refresher

- improving customer service
- an update on traffic law

Taxi Driver Safeguarding Course

Green Penny (video session)

FAA Level1 Award in Awareness of Safeguarding (RQF) - course accredited by The CPD Certification Service

The aim of the course is to enable drivers to develop their understanding of how to safeguard and protect children, young people and vulnerable adults and how to respond to evidence or concerns. Candidates will take a knowledge test based on the course content – those who fail the assessment will need to rebook and pay for the course again.

Blue Lamp Trust (eLearning course or online virtual classroom session)

The course contents includes:

- understanding what is meant by the term 'Safeguarding'.
- identifying adults at risk and other vulnerable people.
- understanding what is meant by Child Sexual and Criminal Exploitation, Human Trafficking, Modern Slavery and Domestic Abuse.
- recognising types of abuse, associated signs and indicators.
- identifying suspicious activities.
- how to report concerns and to whom.
- understanding their safeguarding responsibilities and best practice protocols.
- Police approved online course

Taxi Driver Disability Awareness Course

Green Penny (video session)

Course objectives:

to enable new and existing taxi drivers to develop their understanding of how to recognise and support customers with disability, understand relevant legislation and ensure customers receive a high level of service

Blue Lamp Trust (online virtual classroom session)

The course contents includes:

- understanding what is meant by the term disability
- understanding the law and legal requirements around disability
- understanding different types of disability
- understanding how to load and secure passengers and wheelchairs
- understanding best practice when interacting with a disabled passenger
- understanding the regulations about assistance dogs
- understanding their duty of care responsibilities and best practice protocols
- learning is consolidated via Knowledge Check Questions throughout the course.

Standard Taxi Assessment - Predominantly used to assess new applicants.

<u>Green Penny</u> (Standard cars only – all tests with a driven element are carried out in drivers own vehicle)

The course contents are designed to test:

- eyesight meets the legal requirements.
- safe standard of driving.
- manoeuvring turn the vehicle around to face the opposite direction.
- 10 minutes of driving without turn-by-turn instructions.
- a roadside stop, as if passengers are disembarking.
- relevant knowledge e.g. What to do if a passenger leaves property in the vehicle.
- knowledge on the Highway Code, traffic signs and road markings.
- emergency stop (at the assessor's discretion).

<u>Blue Lamp Trust</u> (For vehicles with less than 9 passenger seats – all tests with a driven element are carried out in drivers own vehicle) <u>LA need to register with Blue Lamp in advance to use this option</u>.

The course contents includes:

- driving licence check
- eyesight check.
- 45 minute driving assessment across a variety of road types.
- perform 2 reversing manoeuvres.
- emergency stop (at the assessor's discretion).
- requires a high level of driving competency. Drivers must make no serious or dangerous driving faults and no more than 9 driving faults in total.

Enhanced Assessment (Standard Assessment plus Wheelchair

Assessment) - Predominantly used to assess new applicants.

Green Penny (Wheelchair accessible vehicles only)

Includes all the elements of the standard assessment plus:

• safely load and unload a wheelchair in their vehicle.

- use the wheelchair brakes to secure and release it.
- fasten the seatbelts or safety harness.
- secure and wheel belts or clamps fitted to the vehicle.

<u>Blue Lamp Trust</u> (Wheelchair accessible vehicles only) LA need to register with Blue Lamp in advance to use this option.

Includes all the elements of the standard assessment plus:

- correctly positioning the vehicle for disabled access.
- assembly of the wheelchair ramp/lift.
- securing the wheelchair passenger in place using clamping equipment.
- safely unloading the wheelchair.
- the driver will be expected to provide a running commentary/role play throughout.

Standalone Wheelchair Assessment

Green Penny (Wheelchair accessible vehicles only)

Blue Lamp Trust (Wheelchair accessible vehicles only) LA need to register with Blue Lamp in advance to use this option.

Swale Street Knowledge Test (Swale House – online test) (usually the first Thursday of the month)

Recap of previously provided safeguarding presentation.

55 multiple choice questions designed to test the driver's knowledge on:

- Area Routes
- Swale Routes
- Numeracy
- Policy
- Highway code
- Road signs
- Safeguarding
- Places in Swale
