<b>Prevention of Crime &amp; Disorder</b>	As an immediate neighbour of the venue I of course am witness to the disorder of revellers leaving drunk in the early hours of the morning. There is already guaranteed racket and disorder with any existing permissions and I fear this will inevitably worsen if the events are increased and the hours are extended.


	I live in the flats overlooking the venue and owing to
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<b>Prevention of Public Nuisance</b>	inadequate sound insulation of the venue find it already impossible to sleep when the disco is open. To increase the number of events and extend them to 4am is simply outrageous and guarantees nuisance and misery for all of us as we struggle to sleep.
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<b>Protection of Children from Harm</b>	Any festivals of the proposed nature will inevitably endanger my 13 year old child and many others as they will be prohibited from playing in their own neighbourhood while hundreds of drunk and rowdy adults take over. This will invariably become a dangerous environment for the local kids to play. Emphasis at Dreamland should be on children, not rowdy ravers who would be better suited to a suitably sound-proofed club venue that doesn't inconvenience or exempt the hundreds of young and elderly neighbours.
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<b>Public Safety</b>	Margate Sands already attracts plenty of visitors and proves problematic enough for the public services to keep up with the fights and accidents on the beach, promenade and pubs. I do not think we have the capacity for yet more anti-social behaviour to be accommodated in this specific spot.
