We parked in the car park and the music although audible did not seem excessive. We entered the premises Mr [redacted] had his windows open and the music was clearly audible and intrusive from Dreamland. We asked Mr [redacted] to close the window, which did not make a huge difference to the sound as he only has single glazed units.</p> <p>We asked Mr [redacted] to turn his TV on at the normal level of volume and the music was intrusive and Mr [redacted] would have had to turn his TV up louder to enable him to watch and enjoy a programme.</p> <p>The music was also intrusive in Mr [redacted] bedroom and would prevent him from being able to sleep.</p>

OFFICER REPORT
<p>From our previous call we headed to Arlington House, Margate, which was very busy, hot with no wind.</p> <p>We entered the residents car park and saw a man with a mobile microphone on a stand pointing towards Dreamland park, this was behind the big tin building I believe, Hall by the Sea. We observed from the car park for approx 10 minutes.</p> <p>A woman was singing and cheering could easily be heard from the crowd.</p> <p>Once inside I noticed the window was open. It was a very hot evening, the same woman was singing the music even louder in the flat. I asked Mr [redacted] to put the TV on, he usually has the sound half way, I could not hear what was being said, he then turned it up ¾ which then could be heard. Mr [redacted] then closed the window, music could still be heard but was not as loud. We then went into Mr [redacted] bedroom which was next door and has the same view on the arena. Again the music could be heard with the window open and slightly less if closed. I learnt that a support act was playing at the moment and after Simply Red were playing.</p> <p>Mr [redacted] has a personal recorder, he turned it on whilst we were there, with the window open standing by it it read 70/73 dbs. Mr [redacted] explained that he is having a recorder put in soon. He is keeping log sheets.</p> <p>Whilst we were driving to [redacted] we had a call from Mr [redacted] at Flat [redacted], at 20:14 we said we were on our way to Arlington House and would make contact after. Whilst in [redacted] I</p>

looked on my tablet and realised Mr [redacted] had given me Mr [redacted] wk number. On further investigation I could not find anything for Flat

At 21:06 as we finished at [redacted] I called Mr [redacted] and explained that he does not have a WK number so I could not visit. I asked him how he got the Wincs number and also the wk number. He said he is part of the Arlington House Association and was given that number and told to use it. He said that he used the service last week and that 2 officers attended. I asked him for his case worker, however he could not answer this. I double checked the Wincs sheet and could not find [redacted]

After a few minutes later he phoned again, to say that he doesn't understand as he is having a recorder put in this week, I said that I would pass details on to get someone to make contact with him.

I then returned to Broadstairs for Jade Malyn to collect her car 21.30

OFFICER REPORT
<p>Arrived at Residents Car Park, Arlington House, Margate. I could clearly hear live music being played from Dreamland and could hear female vocals. I noted a man sitting in his car and he had a noise recorder set up in the car park. Whilst waiting by the internal lift to go up to Mr flat, I could still hear the music inside the building. 20:35 I stood in Mr living room which directly overlooks Dreamland and you can clearly see the stage. The window was open and live music can clearly be heard in the flat. In my opinion, the music sounds louder in his flat than in the car park area. Mr stated he is getting a noise recorder on 24/8/22. I could clearly hear female vocals and the beat of the music. Mr put his TV on and set the volume to halfway, you could hear the music over the TV, he had to turn it up to $\frac{3}{4}$ for you to be able to hear the TV. Mr then closed the window and kept the TV volume at $\frac{3}{4}$ you could hear the TV a bit better, he then turned it down to halfway and you could still hear the music over the TV. We went into Mr bedroom, the window was closed and you could hear the music, at this time there was a heavy drum beat. He opened the window and it was very loud, you would not be able to sleep. Mr stated Dreamland should have their noise set at 65 decibels as per their Premises Licence, however, he said he has not been able to obtain a copy of it. Advised him to contact licensing@thanet.gov.uk Mr I has his own noise recorder and with the window open it was showing between 72 - 76 decibels. 20:55 live music stops and loud</p>

<p>I picked up my support Officer Jade Malyn from St Peters and headed to Arlington House. Margate was extremely busy due to it being the Pride Festival, it was very hot with little breeze.</p> <p>When we arrived at the residents' car park we could easily hear women singing, with a backing band.</p> <p>Once inside Flat the window was open and the TV up loud to be heard. Mr explained the Sugar Babes were playing as it is part of the Pride Festival. He went on to say that a sound monitor man was again outside in the car park at approximately 21:00 - 21:20 and the music was turned down slightly.</p> <p>Mr reading from his noise monitor fluctuated between 73/75dbs, this reading was taken with the window open, standing nearby. He then closed the window and it was reading in the mid 50's.</p> <p>Clear vocals could be heard, and when a popular song came on (21:36) I could hear singing and cheering from the crowd. Again the music was louder in the flat then the car park.</p> <p>Mr explained that he is still after an updated copy of their licence and has asked many times.</p> <p>Again we listened in the car park.</p> <p>I dropped Jade home at 22:00.</p> <p>Video and photos taken.</p>

<p>Music was clearly audible outside coming from Dreamland when I parked in Buenos Ayres and on the approach to the complainants property.</p> <p>The windows were open when we arrived at the complainants property. The music from a live event was extremely loud and the vocals could be heard clearly. Mr I had a noise reader at the property. We asked for the windows to be closed and the music and vocals were still very loud. In between songs, you could hear the artist talking to the crowd quite clearly. The reader showed a reading of 71.4db with the windows shut at 9.50pm and 75.3db when the window was opened. There was no tv in the room, however, it was clear if there had been the noise from the live event would have been heard over it.</p> <p>He wanted to call us back out at 11pm as he said the after party in the Hall by the Sea building would also be very loud. As this was not on the call out list we said we couldn't attend but we would mention it in the report.</p>

The music could clearly be heard throughout the block of flats, including the communal areas and outside. Inside Mr [redacted] flat at [redacted] the music was very loud, I had to raise my voice to be heard. The window in the living room was open and the music was very clear and loud. Both music and crowd noise could be heard. Mr [redacted] closed the window in the living room, this had little effect on the noise volume. Music could still be heard. Mr [redacted] put the T.V on at volume level 15, which is the level he would normally watch it on. The music could easily be heard over the T.V. The noise level would prevent the ability to hear the T.V in the living space. I moved into the bedroom and the noise level was the same as in the living room. The music at this level would effect the ability to sleep. The music finished at 22:17, the noise level dropped and all that could be heard was people moving and leaving the venue.</p>

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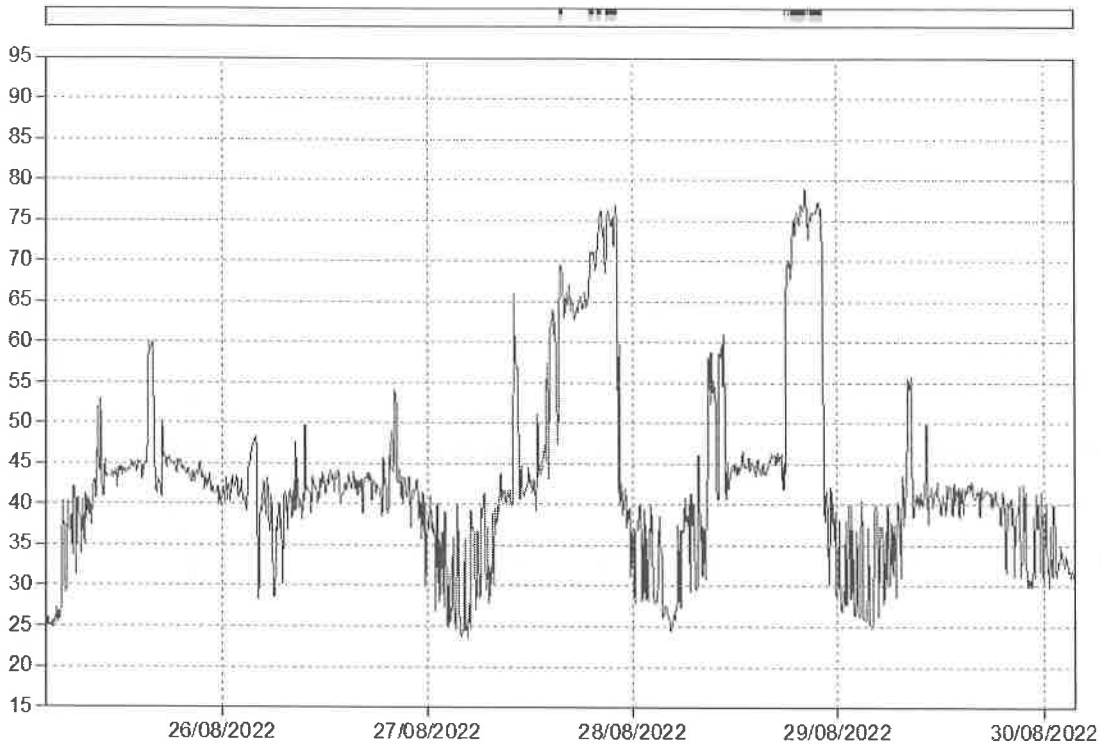

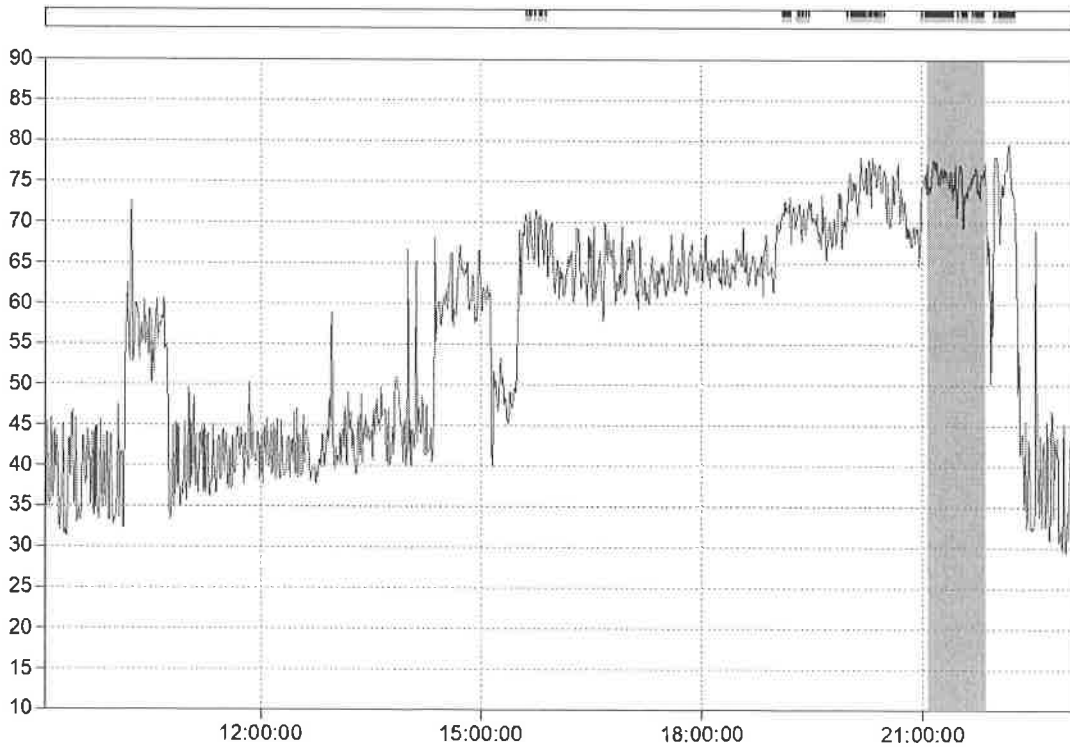

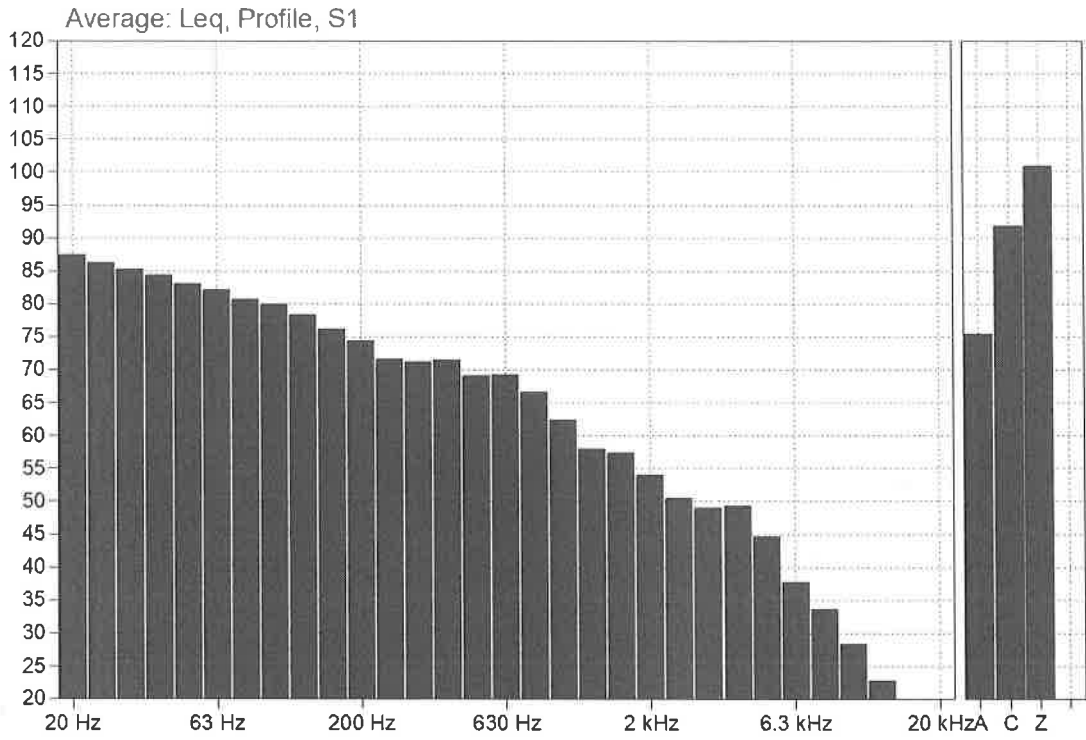


LAeq15mins 77dBA

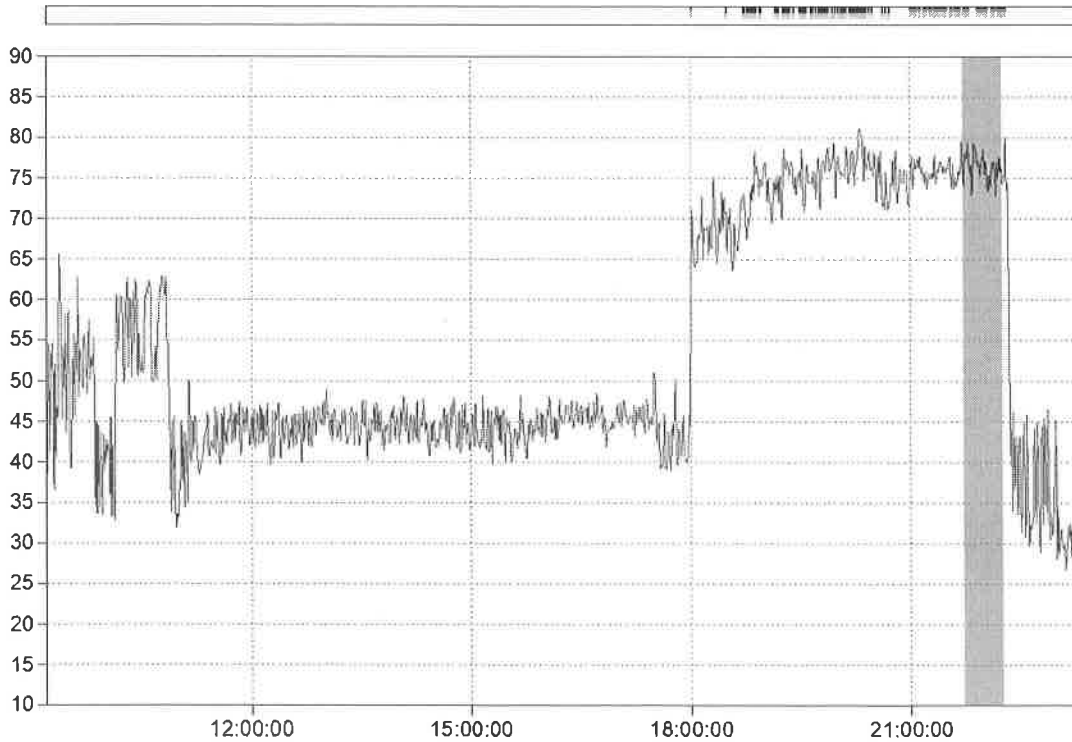

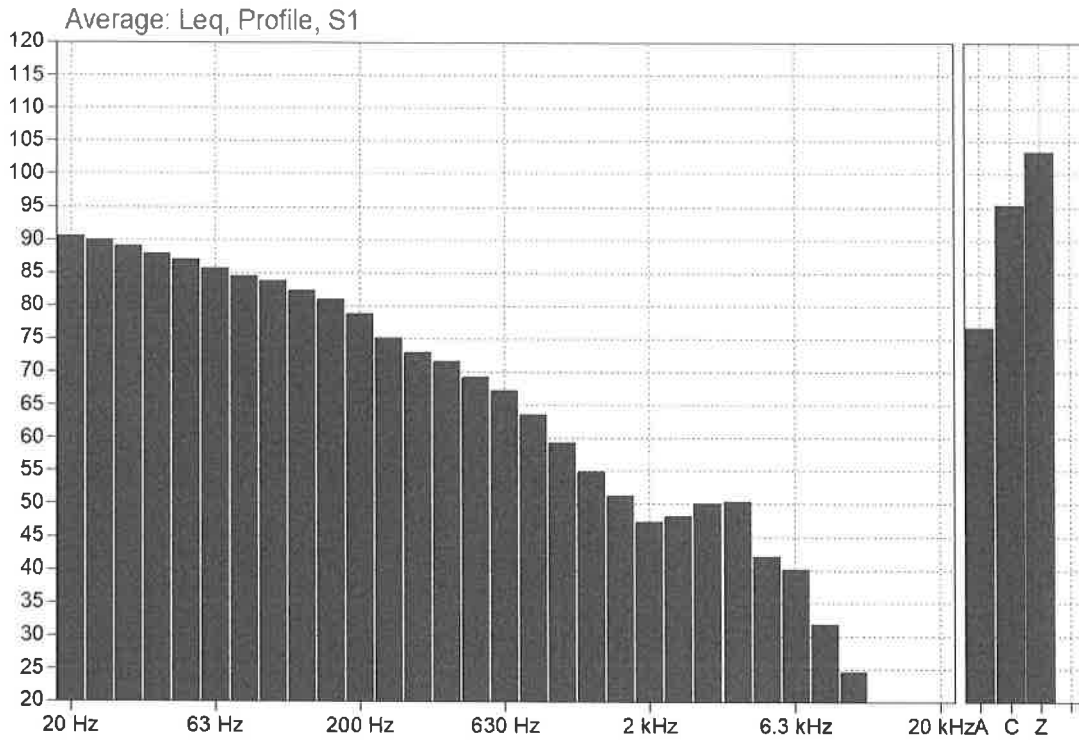


LAeq 30mins 74dBA

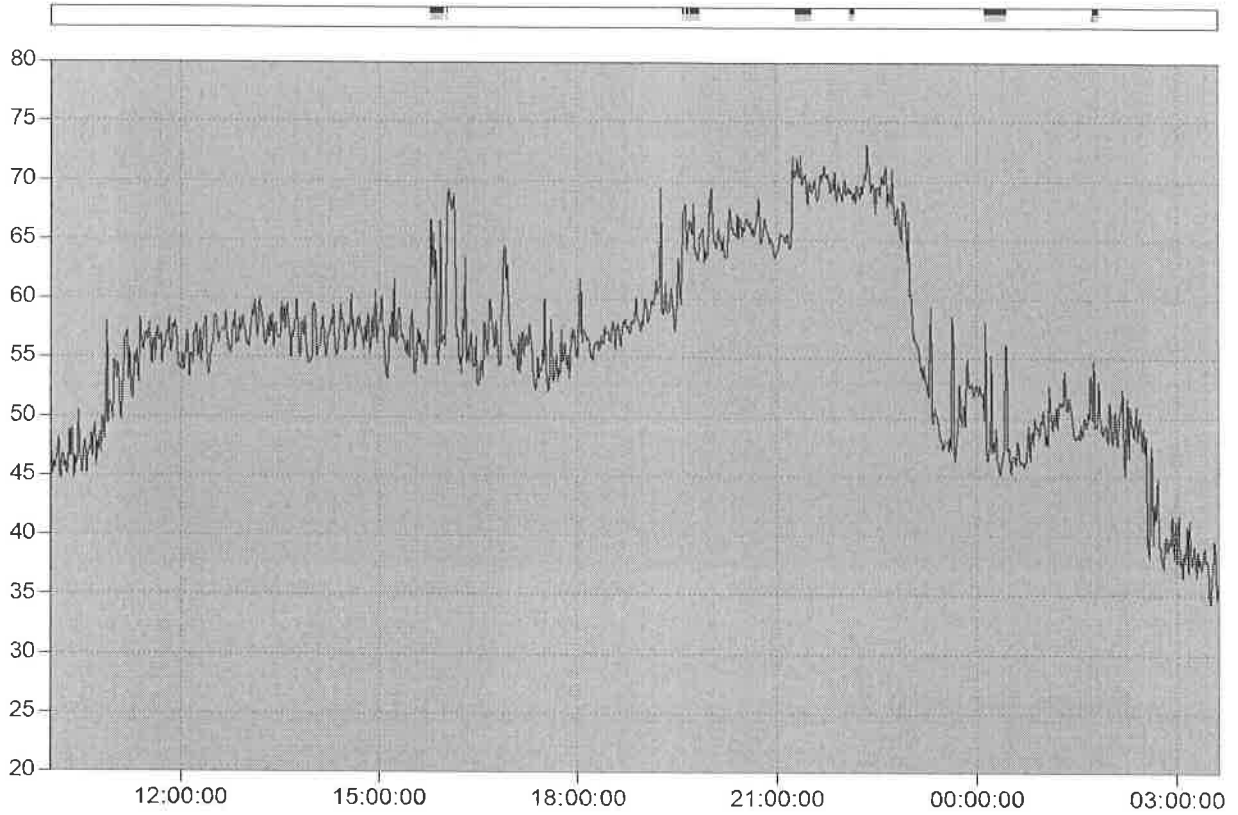

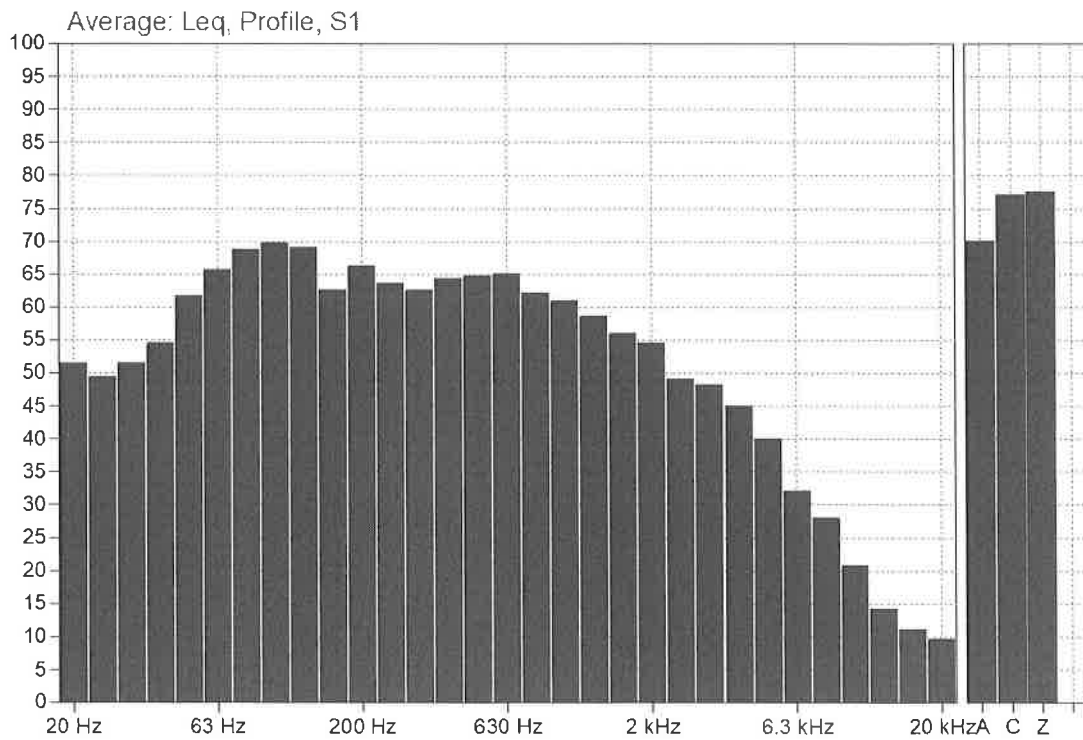
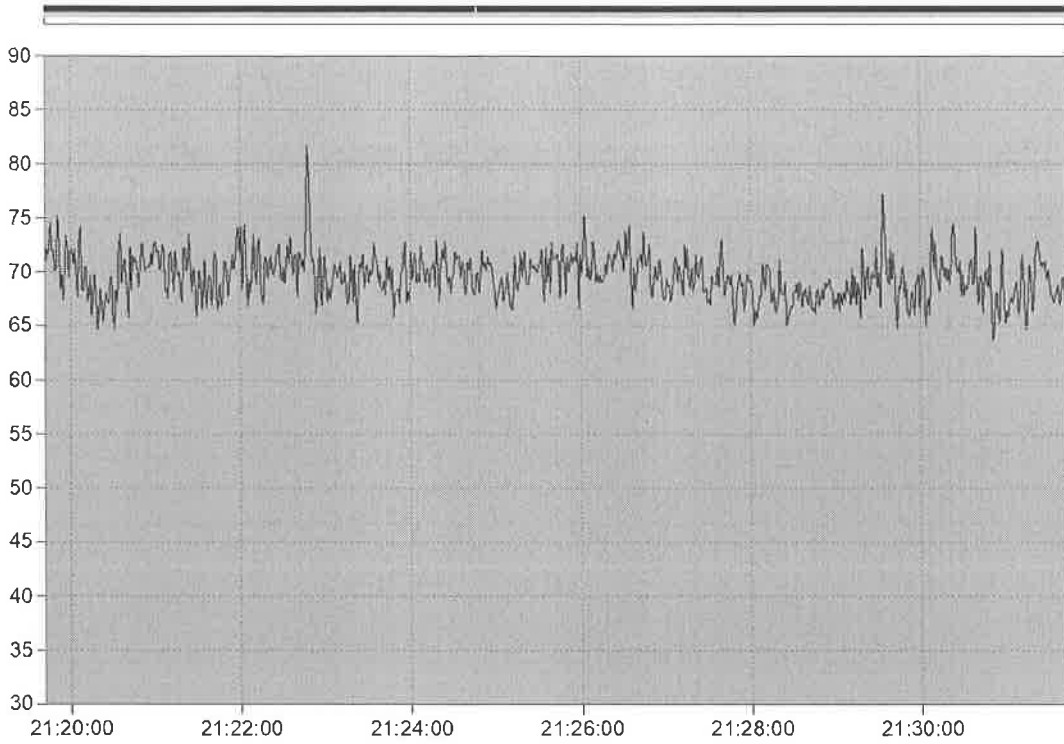
